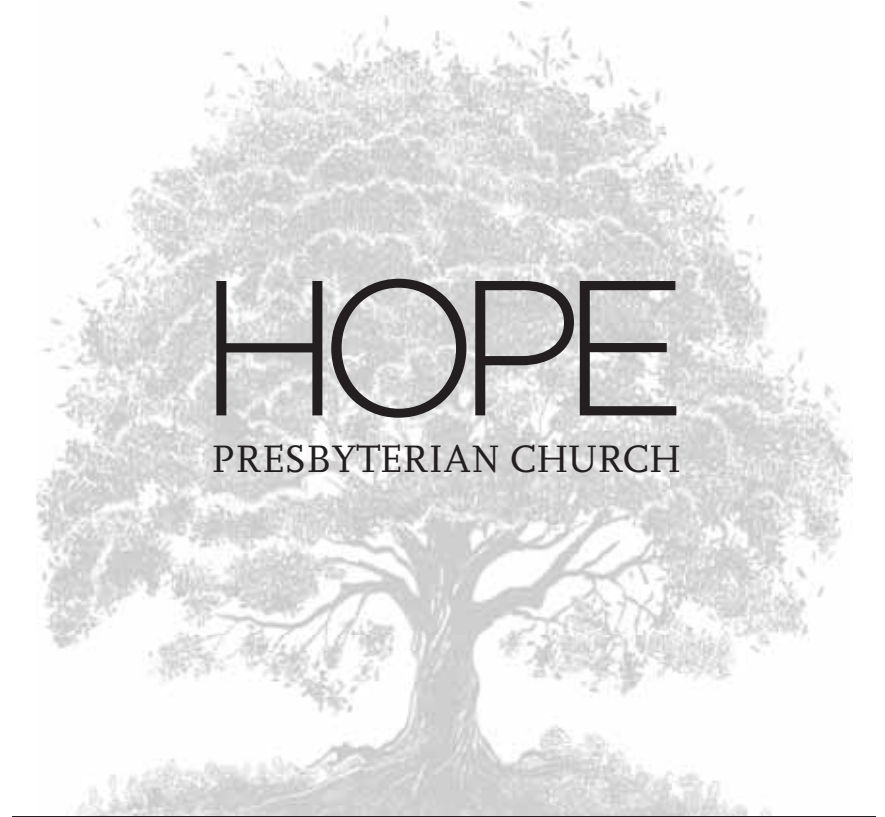

83. What is the Office of the Keys?
